NEWS FROM OUR MEMBERS

From Greg Casarotti . . . This winter ,which is still in full force, I've changed the single bowl master cylinder to a dual bowl and installed the brake lines under the car out of sight. I know that originally they were under the hood and I didn't think they looked very nice wrapping around the shock towers like was done by whoever put the disc brakes on the front. If someone is doing this NAPA has a tee fitting # 652X3 that allows the stop light switch to be back of the hood on the '64 for \$10 including tax. I noticed in most of the catalogs this tee starts at \$19.95 plus shipping. MMM... ??

While bleeding the brakes I noticed I had a rear axle seal leaking so I replaced that and thank goodness I caught it when I did thus not ruining the brake shoes with axle lubricant. I recall when I was a kid working for the NAPA Jobber in Front Royal the Ret. Col. A.W. Lawrence, who owned the place and I had to salute every morning, would allow us to sell 1/2 set of brake shoes to the customer in this situation. Try that now, yeah, right!

Since I've started driving the car, I've noticed a slight oil leak on the front of the engine and thought this would be a good time to address that problem, thinking it was the front oil seal since the car before I got it had not been driven since '91. That was not the problem as I found out when taking the parts off to replace the seal. If whoever put the '66 Fairlane engine in the car had put all the bolts in the water pump/timing case cover it may have held oil. There should be 9 bolts that holds these 2 parts to the engine, and he thought that only 7 were needed, along with lots of Permatex, and I mean lots. This gave me an excuse to clean up the front of the engine and replace the cruddy stuff along with the proper amount of bolts. For those that are interested, Tractor Supply sells Grade 8 Bolts by the pound in all sizes. I bought enough bolts and lock washers ,20 plus a few spares, for \$4.28. It is hard to believe that for another project I bought 3 bolts grade 8 at ACE Hardware and paid \$3.30 for the 3 bolts.

Hopefully I'll see you folks at the February meeting.

Makes 3-4 servings.

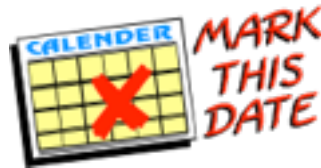
Note: Goes well with baked ham.
